Museum Rules

Please Do Not Touch

Due to the oils in your skin, even the lightest touch can damage a work of art, so please don't touch. Be careful to keep your hands, bags, and bodies a safe distance from artwork. To avoid accidentally bumping into and damaging works of art, running and roughhousing are not allowed.

Talk About It

We encourage discussion in the galleries, but please be courteous to others. If you need to talk on your cell phone, stay in lobby areas. Please turn off or set phones to vibrate before entering the galleries.

Pack a Camera

Personal, non-commercial photography without flash is permitted in our permanent collection areas. Some exhibitions cannot be photographed. The use of tripods, flash, or video cameras requires prior permission.

Don't Eat or Drink in the Galleries

Food, gum, and beverages are not allowed in the galleries.

Stow Your Bags

Umbrellas, backpacks, and large bags (over 12"x16") are not permitted in the galleries. Speak with our staff about free lockers.

Pencils Only, Please

Feel free to sketch with pencil in the galleries. Pens are not allowed.
